



### Option A: 1-hour virtual welfare consultation one on one with a qualified animal welfare scientist

#### Who should sign up for a Welfare 1 to 1 1-hour consultation?

These sessions are for anyone who wants an expert opinion on a general or specific welfare question or issue. The aim is to develop your understanding of the overall welfare of your animal, in other words, what its overall quality of life is likely to be, as opposed to focusing on single aspects of its health, training, or housing. We then help you find solutions to improve welfare!

#### What comes with a consultation session?

- Scientific explanation of welfare issue
- Summary of likely causes
- Knowledge and tools to monitor it
- Suggested actions to improve welfare
- Written summary of the above



#### How much does it cost?

#### What kinds of issues will a Welfare 1 to 1 address?

Anything that you as an owner, keeper, trainer, or stakeholder identify as a welfare concern, but aren't able to treat. Or, you may just want to brainstorm ways to optimise your animal(s) welfare!

#### Welfare issue examples:

- The zoo animal you care for seems to anticipate feeding time a lot, and you don't know if it's an abnormal behaviour or not
- Your cats don't seem to get on with each other, and you don't know how to improve their relationship
- You don't have a specific issue, but you want to learn more about stereotypic behaviour and how to recognise it
